### **Musical Director – Andrew Snell**

Born in Taunton, Somerset, Andrew started playing the trombone at the age of 10. After playing with the local town bands, county youth bands and orchestras, he studied at University College, Salford. After gaining a BA (Hons) in Band Musicianship, he took up the position of Bass Trombone with the world-renowned Grimethorpe Colliery Band. Andrew left Grimethorpe in 2002 and immigrated to New Zealand where he was engaged as Musical Director with Waitakere City 'Trusts' Brass.

In 2004 Andrew moved to Australia and has worked as Lecturer in Brass and Musicianship at Charles Darwin University, Orchestra Manager for the Australian Opera and Ballet Orchestra (Opera Australia) in Sydney and Chief Executive Officer of the Wollongong Conservatorium of Music. In October 2013 he took up the position of Managing Director of Victorian Opera and became Musical Director of Darebin City Brass, Preston Band in September 2015. Andrew moved to Christchurch in 2019, where he worked as Manager, Performing Arts at Ara Institute but has now returned to Victoria to continue working in the field of arts administration.

### **Musical Director - Reuben Brown**

Hailing from Invercargill, Reuben recently completed his Honours degree at Te Kōkī - New Zealand School of Music, where he pursued his passions for orchestral conducting and euphonium performance.

A National Youth Brass band member from 2020 to 2022, Reuben plays euphonium with Wellington Brass Band and is the band's manager and Assistant Musical Director. In 2022, Reuben was awarded an NZSO's Conducting Fellowship, working with the orchestra over sessions led by Hamish McKeich and various visiting conductors. He was also a finalist for the Australian Conducting Academy.

Reuben is the Artistic Coordinator at the New Zealand Symphony Orchestra, assisting in current and future projects. He also tutors at the Pōneke Brass Academy and Buzzing Brass.

### **Guest Soloist - Ross Gerritsen**

Ross is the 2022 National Baritone Champion and a 7-time member of the National Band of New Zealand. He was awarded the MVP of the 2017 band, which placed second at the World Music Contest in Kerkrade, the Netherlands.

After growing up and learning cornet in Whanganui, Ross moved to Auckland, where he did most of his banding with Waitakere City Brass and Dalewood Auckland Brass. During that time, he won a national baritone title, three national duet championships and the A Grade band championship. Ross played the euphonium in the 1998, 1999 and 2000 National Youth Bands before starting his teaching career.

Ross is Head of Arts at Nayland College, Nelson, and a member of NBS Nelson City Brass. Before moving to Nelson in January, Ross, his wife Siobhan, and their children spent three-and-a-half years living in Thailand, where he was Head of Performing Arts at Regents International School, Pattaya. He was Head of Music at Saint Kentigern College for 13 years producing, directing and music directing a number of musicals, including the Phantom of the Opera, Les Miserables and West Side Story.
